Immerse Yourself in River Adventures

Campbell County is a paradise for river adventurers. Begin your scenic journey from downtown Lynchburg and conclude it in Campbell County with leisurely floats and paddles. Thrill-seekers can conquer the exhilarating Fish Trap (Class III) and Cat Rock (Class II) rapids between Long Island and Brookneal. Motorboat enthusiasts can explore large sections of the Staunton River from accessible ramps in Altavista, Long Island, and Brookneal. For nature lovers, the undeveloped shorelines along the James and Staunton Rivers provide abundant bird-watching and wildlife spotting opportunities. Try your luck at fishing for catfish, bass, crappie, sunfish, and walleye in the bountiful Staunton River.

FISHING ON THE STAUNTON RIVER

DALTON'S LANDING

BOAT SLIDE Only a 3-mile drive between the Dam and Dalton's makes for easy vehicle shuttling. Dam to Dalton's is the shortest leg of the Staunton River—great for afternoons or trips with youngsters.

ALTAVISTA BOAT RAMP (ENGLISH PARK)

CONCRETE RAMP Glide glong English Park—check out the scenic bridges crossing in this area. Highly picturesque area with excellent fishing.

6 LONG ISLAND PARK

CONCRETE RAMP Camp along the river or start here for Class II rapids near FishTrap and Cat Rock Sluice on the way to Brookneal. Virginia Bird and Wildlife Trail's Staunton River Loop begins here.
